



BARBRI: Demystifying Bar Exam Terms!

BOLE – Board of Law Examiners

MPRE – Multistate Professional Responsibility Exam (free BARBRI course to pass this)

UBE – Uniform Bar Exam (MBE + MEE + MPT)

MBE – Multistate Bar Exam (national, scaled multiple choice portion of the bar exam)

MEE – Multistate Essay Exam (UBE multitopic essays)

MPT – Multistate Performance Test (UBE closed-universe “think like a lawyer” section)

PT – Performance Test (like UBE version, but can be state specific, like “CPT” for California’s exam)

NYLC – New York Law Course

NYLE – New York Law Exam

C&F – Character and Fitness

NCBE – National Conference of Bar Examiners

ABA – American Bar Association

PSP – Personal Study Plan (in your BARBRI course)
