BECKY WOLOZIN: I met Jackie Bhabha my first year of law school. I was connected by another professor, professor Gregory, who knew that I was interested in children's issues and international work. And when I met her, I was helping her with a briefing for Save the Children on transnational migration of children around the world, and that was actually the first time that I learned about that topic and issue.

Jackie is just an incredibly inspiring woman. She's passionate and intelligent, and she was the first person that I met that was really interdisciplinary in the way that I had envisioned my own work coming into law school and my joint degree at the education school. I've continue to work with Jackie, and she's been an incredible mentor and supporter in the work that I'm doing and in even just being a smiling and encouraging face in my various endeavors here. And I couldn't think of somebody more worthy of inspiring others as they walk through Harvard Law School.
